## Round ‘Em Up!

Round the numbers to the nearest ten.
Rounding to the nearest ten
If the ones number is 5 or greater, round up to the nearest ten. Example: $1 \underline{Z} \rightarrow 20$
If the ones number is 4 or less, round down to the nearest ten. Example: $1 \underline{2} \rightarrow 10$

Rounding to the nearest hundred
If the tens number is 5 or greater, round up to the nearest hundred. Example: $1 \underline{6} 1 \rightarrow 200$ If the tens number is $\mathbf{4}$ or less,round down to the nearest hundred. Example: $1 \mathbf{1} 8 \rightarrow 100$
