Practice your Secondary Colors

The butterflies in this garden are missing some colors. The wings of these butterflies are in primary colors. When two primary colors mix together they form a secondary color, which you can see as the body of each butterfly. Ask your child to color the missing primary colors to complete this picture.

Hint: On the first butterfly, what color mixes with yellow to make orange? Each of the helpful flowers on the page add a bit of reading practice, too!
