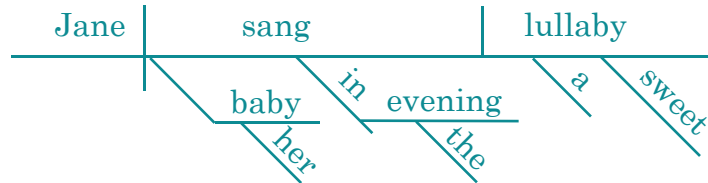


DIAGRAMMING SENTENCES

Diagram the following sentences. Remember that the subject and verb go on a line, with modifiers on a diagonal line underneath the word they modify. Place a direct object on the line with the subject and verb and an indirect object under the verb.

Example: Jane sang her baby a sweet lullaby in the evening.

We watched the pink and gold sunset from the beach.

The guests ate chicken and a salad at lunch.

Our white car smoked and rattled loudly.
