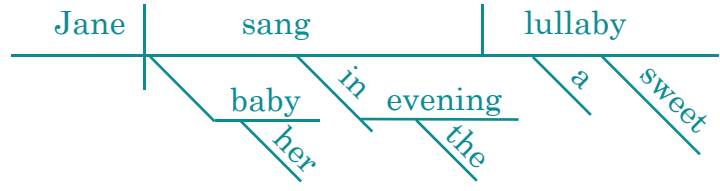


DIAGRAMMING SENTENCES

Diagram the following sentences. Remember that the subject and verb go on a line, with modifiers on a diagonal line underneath the word they modify. Place a direct object on the line with the subject and verb. Place an indirect object under the verb.

Example: Jane sang her baby a sweet lullaby in the evening.

Lisa and Tammy watched movies and cartoons over the weekend.

The giant elephant gently lifted the blonde woman into the air.

The neighbors mowed the lawn and trimmed the bushes.
