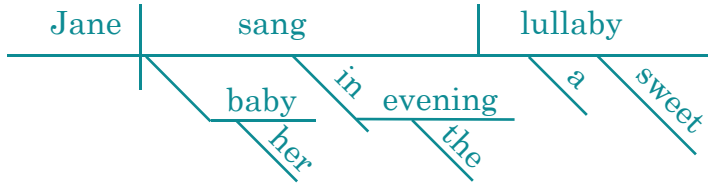


DIAGRAMMING SENTENCES
