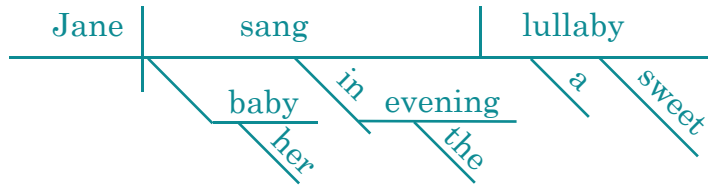


Diagram the following sentences. Remember that the subject and verb go on a line, with modifiers on a diagonal line underneath the word they modify. Place a direct object on the line with the subject and verb. Place an indirect object under the verb.

Example: Jane sang her baby a sweet lullaby in the evening.



He read a very interesting book from the library.

Carrie saw the red and yellow bird in the upstairs window.

I heard a noise in the bushes by the door.

The new bicycle and the broken skateboard belong to Tom.
