Bull: the bull is one of the national animals of Spain, often represented by the Osborne Bull, which is the image of a black bull in semi profile.

Eagle: the eagle is one of the national animals of Spain, specifically the rare Spanish Imperial Eagle. In 2010 there were approximately 279 eagles in Spain.

Clavel: Spanish for "carnation", this flower is the national floral emblem of Spain.

Paella: is considered by many outside of Spain to be one of the national dishes. There are many variations of paella, but they all use rice, saffron, olive oil, vegetables, and often meat.

Flamenco: is a popular dance that originated from Andalusian music in Spain. The main components of flamenco include a guitar, singing, dancing, and clapping.

Tortilla: also called tortilla espanola or tortilla de patata, it is a dish featuring eggs, potatoes, and olive oil, although other ingredients can be added.

Monarchy: Spain currently has a constitutional monarchy made up of King Juan Carlos I and Queen Sophia.

Football: called "futbol" in Spain, this is the most popular sport.
