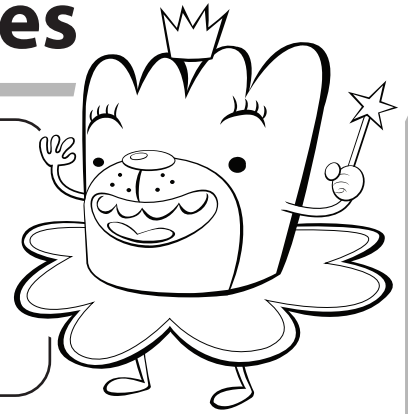


Story Elements in Sentences
