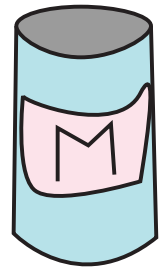
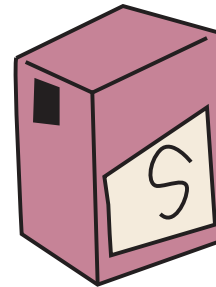
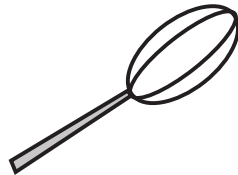
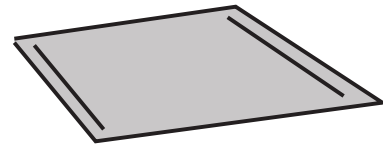
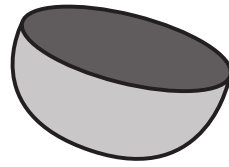


Day of the Dead Sugar Skulls! 🐼

Materials:

- Mixing Bowl
- Whisk
- Cookie Sheet
- Meringue Powder
- Sugar



For every 1 cup of sugar, use 2 teaspoons meringue and 1-1/2 teaspoons water. This makes 1 palm-sized sugar skull! Use this ratio to make as many as you'd like!

How To Make Sugar Skulls!

Step 1: Whisk together the sugar and meringue powder.

Step 2: Sprinkle water until it is the right texture. It should be about one and a half teaspoons. Mix it with your hands!

Step 3: Form little sugar snow balls. Try to pack firmly.

Step 4: Using a spoon, dowel, or your fingers, make two circle indents for eyes and lines for the mouth.

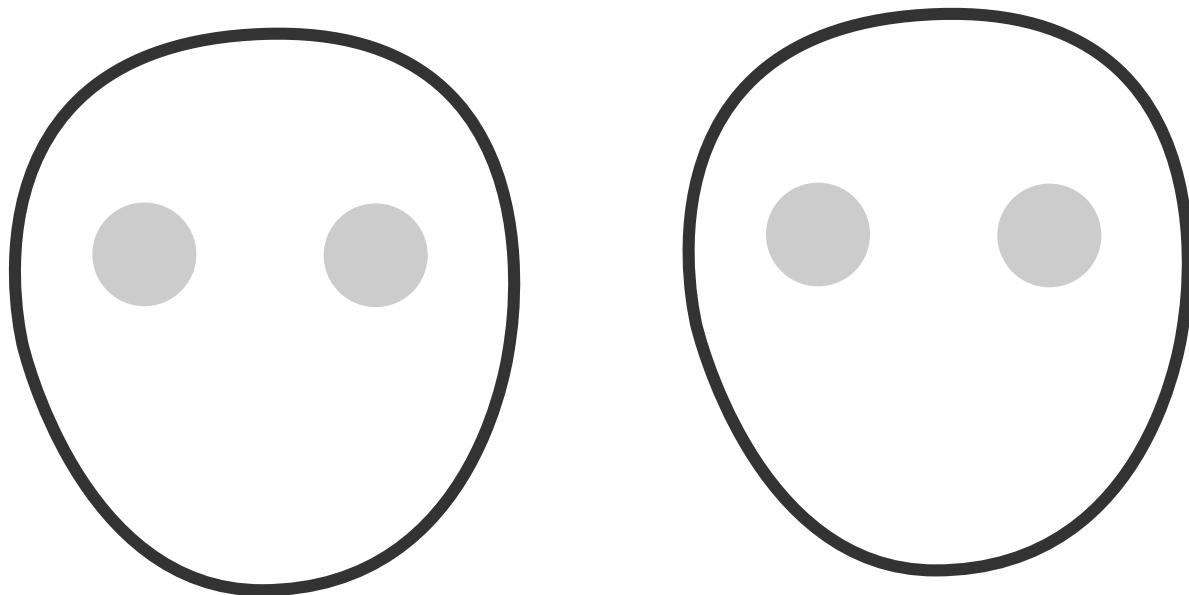
Step 5: Leave your scary sugar skulls out overnight to dry until they're hard as rocks!

Step 6: Use acrylic paint and brushes to decorate!

Note: If you want skulls in different colors, add food dye to your water in step 2. Make them any color you want!
