




For this activity you will need:


- Paper plate
- Red, yellow, and orange tissue paper
- Glue
- 6-8 Yellow construction paper triangles





Do you think the sun is hot or cold? Does it cool us off, or keep us warm? That's right, it keeps us warm. Let's make our own sun using warm colors.





- Red, yellow, and orange are all considered to be warm colors, like fire or flames. Tear your warm-colored tissue paper into medium-sized pieces, and glue them to your paper plate to create a collage or mosaic.
- 2. Let it dry.
- 3. Now glue the yellow triangles around the outside of your plate to complete your sun.
- 4. Draw a face on your sun. Hang it around the house or in a window.
