
Syllable Partners: Ar, Er, and Or

When you find r-controlled vowels (ar, er, or) inside a word, the vowel and the r are always partners! They stay inside the same syllable and are not broken up apart into two different syllables.

Example: version \rightarrow ver-sion

Look closely at each word below. Find the vowel partners and circle them. Then, break apart the word and write each individual syllable on the matching line. The first one is done for you.
