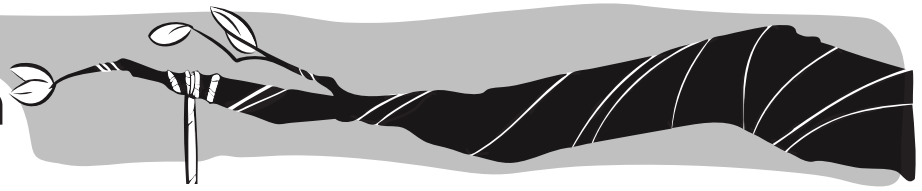


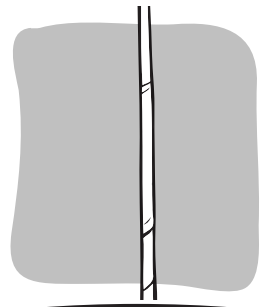
Page versus Screen



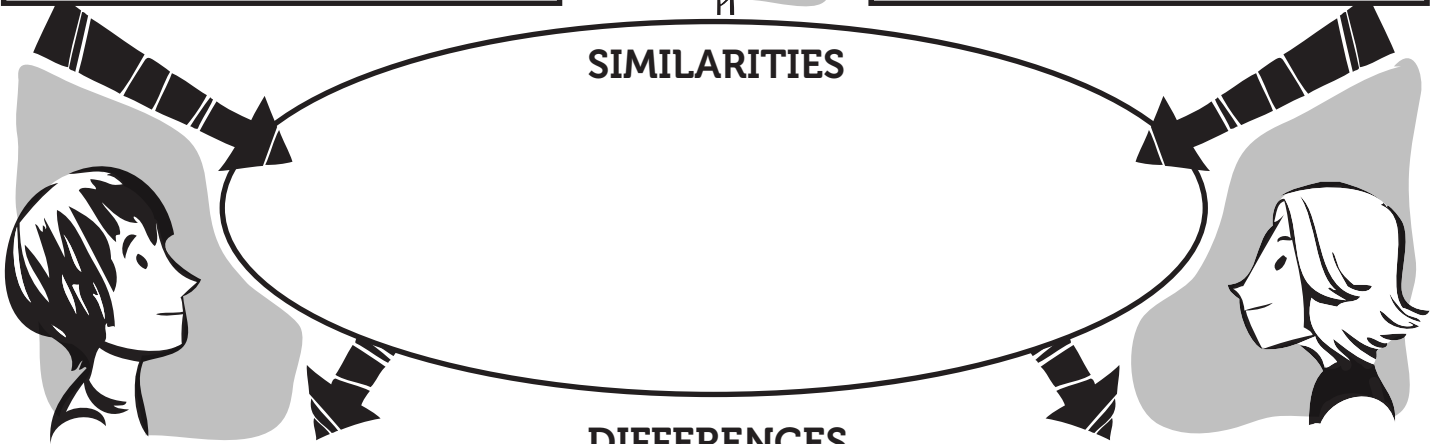

Compare and contrast **Bridge to Terabithia** as a book and as a movie. Then decide how well you like each version of the story!

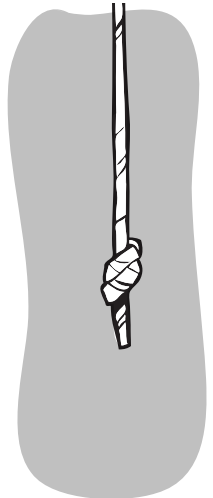
