
Thanksgiving

1. Color 5 of the turkey feathers one color, and the remaining 6 in another. Color in the rest of the turkey, too. 2. Carefully cut out the feathers. 3. Turn them over and add a spot of glue onto the bottom of each one. 4. Glue down the 6 back row feathers first using the outside brown line as a guide. 5. Then add the 5 front row ones along the back of the bird. 6. Let dry, then ruffle or bend the feathers a little to get a great dimensional look. Be sure to write "Happy Thanksgiving!"

Add a drop of glue



on the back.
