

Thanksgiving Banner

Print, then color in as many pieces as you like. Ask a grown-up to help cut out the shapes. To determine how much string, ribbon, or yarn you will need, place all of the finished pieces in a line and measure. Be sure to add about an inch or two for spacing in between the shapes and several inches at both ends for tying. You will also need a hole punch or a pen. If the shapes slide around too much on the string, you will need some tape.



Have a grown-up help tape or tie your banner up in your room or anywhere in the house where there's a space!

place on the banner, add a piece of tape to the back of each to secure the ribbon to the paper.

If the weather is good you can even hang it outside!
