The <u>Great Depression</u> lasted from 1929 to 1939. The government and businesses had <u>policies</u> in the 1930s that favored men over women for jobs. Married women were often the first to be laid off. Unemployment existed in a lot of the country and many companies believed that jobs should be given to male "<u>breadwinners</u>." <u>Nevertheless</u>, unemployment rates among women were lower than for men during the 1930s, largely because jobs were highly <u>segmented</u> by <u>gender</u>. Service sector jobs, like housekeeping and secretarial work, were <u>predominated</u> by women. Jobs focusing on service were less <u>affected</u> by the depression.
