phrase meaning "upper lake"

#### **Lake Huron**

**Surface area:** 23,000 sq. miles **Maximum depth:** 748 feet **Name Origin:** French explorers named it for a local Native

American tribe.

### Lake Michigan

**Surface area:** 22,300 sq. miles **Maximum depth:** 925 feet **Name Origin:** From a Native American word for "great water"

#### **Lake Ontario**

Surface area: 7,340 sq. miles Maximum depth: 804 feet Name Origin: From a Native American word for "beautiful lake"

#### Lake Erie

**Surface area:** 9,910 sq. miles **Maximum depth:** 210 feet **Name Origin:** From a Native American word for "long tail"
