

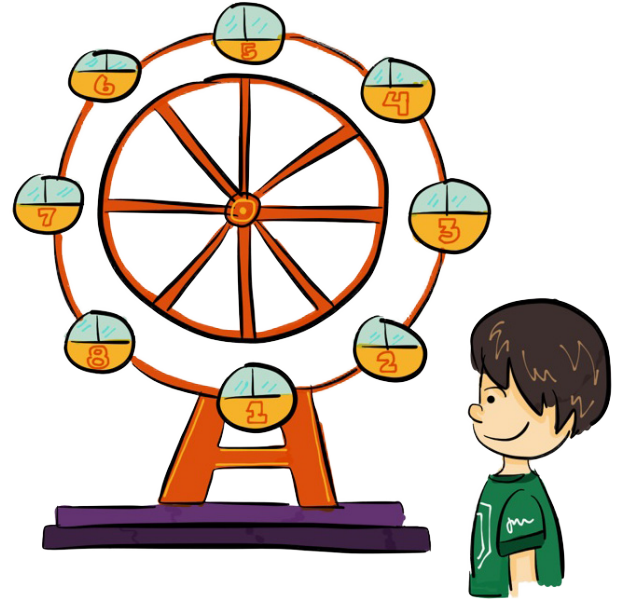
# IS SOMETHING MISSING?

Baban is having a hard time understanding that a complete sentence has a subject and a predicate.

**DIRECTIONS:** Please read through Baban's article about going to the fair, and mark all the complete sentences with a C, and all the incomplete sentences (also called fragments) with an I?

**REMEMBER:** A complete sentence should answer the questions:

- Who is the sentence about?
- What is he doing?



**EXAMPLE:** The child ran across the parking lot. Who? The child. What is he doing? Running across the parking lot. So, "The child ran across the parking lot." is a complete sentence.
