

GUESS MY PRESIDENT!

A Presidential Trivia Game for 2 Players

- 1. Print all pages containing playing cards and cut them up. Each player gets a set of presidents. (To save paper or shorten playing time, you can split it up by century or page whatever you choose, both players must have the same set of cards.)
- 2. Put a book or folder in between you and your opponent so you can't see each other's cards.
- 3. Turn your cards upside down and draw a card. This is the president your opponent will be trying to guess!
- 4. On each turn, you may either ask a question or guess your opponent's president. Questions must be 'yes or no' questions. Great creative questions can be based on either appearance ("Does your president have gray hair?") or fact ("Was your president a Founding Father?").
- 5. For example, one player may ask, "Was your president in office during the 1800s?" If the answer is yes, turn all the presidents that were NOT in office during the 1800s facedown, leaving only those that were as possible answers.
- 6. Keep asking questions until you have a good guess. If you get it right, you win! If you get it wrong, keep going until a player guesses correctly or until both players are stumped.
