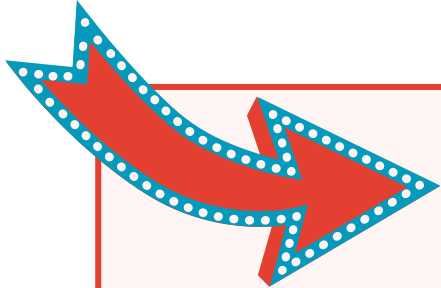


TO, TOO, & TWO

These words sound the same, but they have different meanings.



TO

shows direction or destination

Joshua went to the movie theater.
He carried his popcorn to his seat.

TOO

means *also* or *excessively*

Joshua bought candy, too.
He ate too many snacks and got a stomachache.



TWO

refers to number or quantity

Joshua saw two of his friends at the theater.
The movie started at two o'clock in the afternoon.
