TO, TOO, & TWO

These words sound the same, but they have different meanings.



TO

shows direction or destination

Joshua went **to** the movie theater. He carried his popcorn **to** his seat.

T00

means also or excessively

Joshua bought candy, <u>too</u>. He ate <u>too</u> many snacks and got a stomachache.



TWO

refers to number or quantity

Joshua saw <u>two</u> of his friends at the theater. The movie started at <u>two</u> o'clock in the afternoon.
