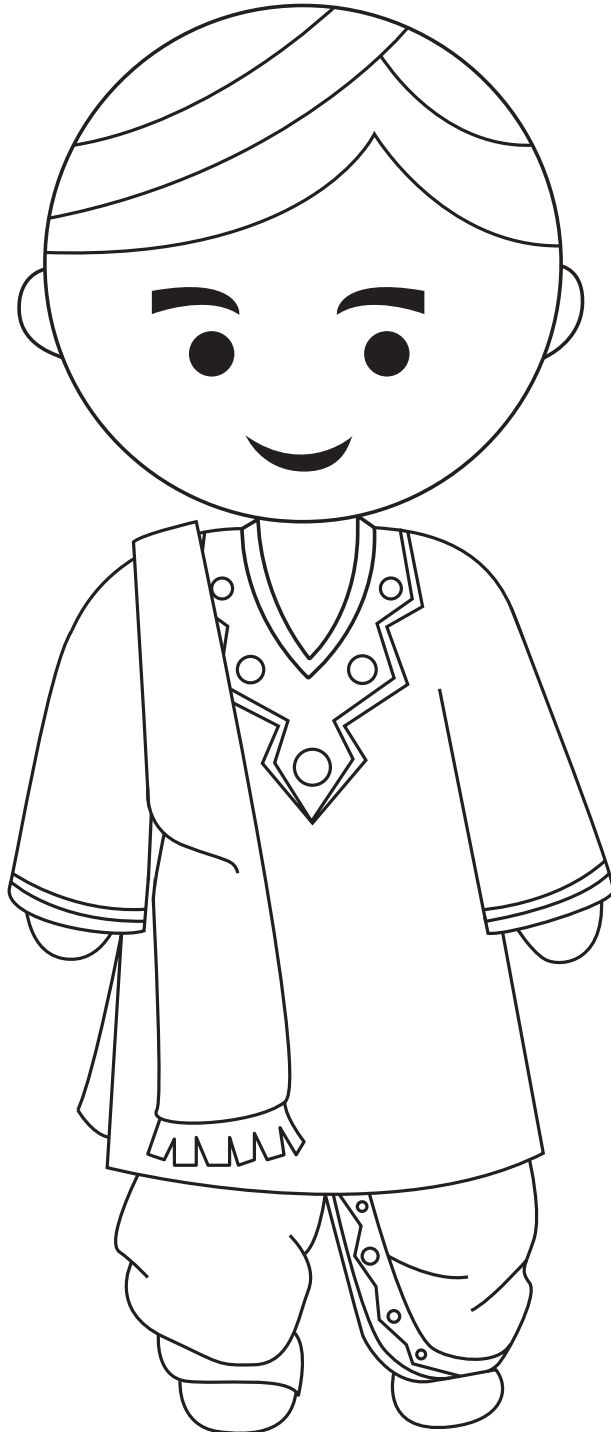

## Dhoti Kurta

is the most traditional of all dresses worn by the men in India.

“Dhoti” is a rectangular piece of unstitched cloth about five yards long, wrapped about the waist and legs and knotted at the waist. It is commonly worn in combination with a “kurta” top, which is a long loose fitting shirt.

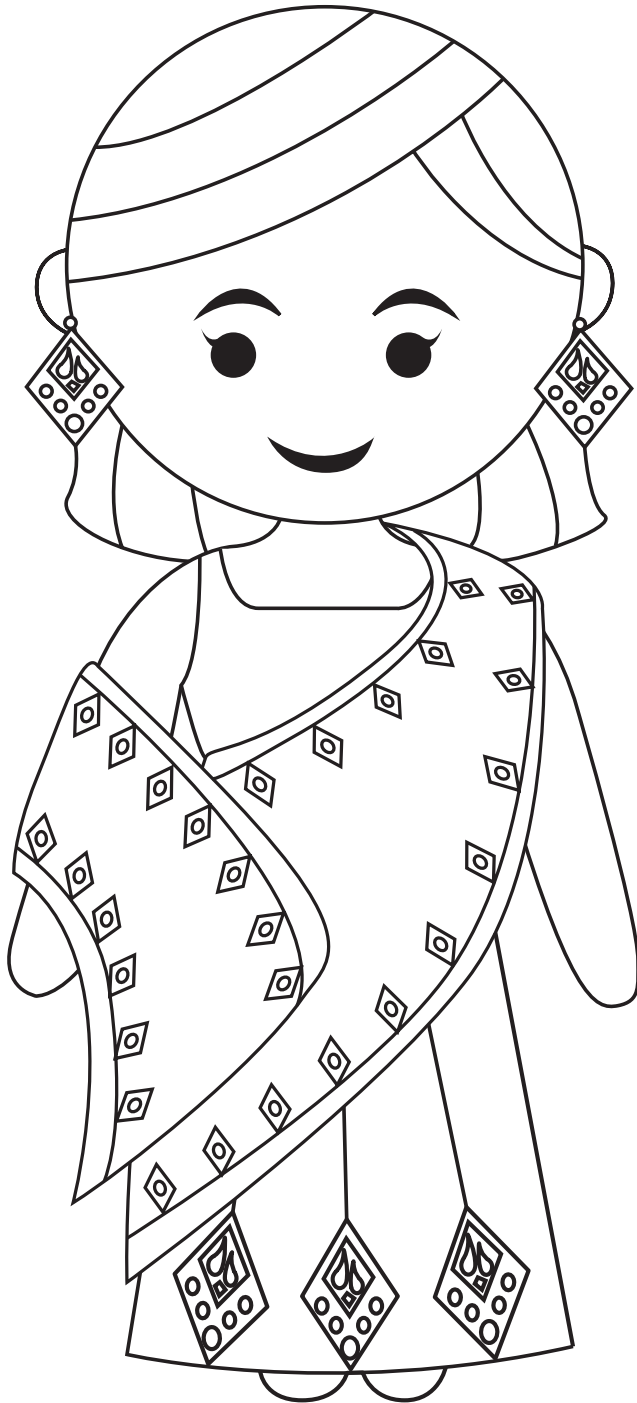
## Question:

## Female Traditional Clothing



## Sari

is generally considered to be one of the most popular forms of traditional Indian dress for women.

It is an outer garment worn chiefly by women in India and Pakistan, consisting of a length of lightweight cloth like silk with one end wrapped about the waist to form a skirt and the other draped over the shoulder or covering the head.

## Question:

Saris are primarily worn in which two countries?

*Answer: India and Pakistan*
