4	TYPES OF PHRASES: Gerund, Infinitive, and Participial Phrases
	Gerunds, infinitives, and participles are verb forms that function as different parts of speech in a sentence.
	A <b>gerund</b> is a type of <u>noun</u> made from the <i>-ing</i> form of a verb. Gerunds and gerund phrases (gerunds + associated modifiers) can act as subjects or objects of verbs. They can also act as objects of prepositions.
	Gavin earned money by mowing his neighbors' lawns.  The gerund phrase functions as the object of the preposition "by."
	An <b>infinitive</b> is formed from the word "to" + the base form of a verb. Infinitives and infinitive phrases (infinitives + associated modifiers) can act as <u>nouns</u> , <u>adjectives</u> , or <u>adverbs</u> in a sentence.
	His goal was to earn enough money for a new mountain bike.  The infinitive phrase functions as a noun.
	A participle is a verb form that is often used as an <u>adjective</u> . A present participle always ends in <i>-ing</i> . A past participle often ends in <i>-ed</i> , <i>-d</i> , <i>-e</i> , <i>-en</i> , or <i>-n</i> , but it may have an irregular form.
	Discouraged by the slow progress, Gavin took on additional jobs around the neighborhood. The participial phrase describes Gavin.
