Rounding to the Nearest 100



When rounding to the nearest 100, first look at the number and determine what multiple of one hundred comes before that number and what multiple of one hundred comes after that number. For example, the number 573 is between 500 and 600. Then, look at the tens place digit. If the digit is I to 4, the number rounds down to the lower multiple of 100. If the digit is 5 to 9, the number rounds to the higher multiple of 100.
