



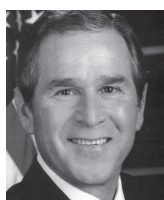
President Matching Game

James
Madison

1. Our 18th president graduated from the Military Academy at West Point. A general during the Civil War, he saw some of the bloodiest battles in history. While president, he was arrested for riding his horse too fast and was fined \$20. He smoked 20 cigars a day. He died of throat cancer.



George W.
Bush

2. Our 30th president was born on Fourth of July. He was Vice President under Harding. He sent U.S. Marines to Nicaragua in 1925. He was the only president sworn into office by his father, a justice of the peace. He slept nine hours every night and took two-hour afternoon naps.



Ulysses
Grant

3. His face is on the \$5000 bill. He graduated from the College of New Jersey in 1771 (now Princeton University). He declared war on Britain in 1812, and in 1814 British troops burned the White House. He was the first president to wear trousers instead of knee breeches. At 5 feet 4 inches, he was the shortest president.



Dwight
Eisenhower

4. Our 43rd president graduated from Yale and Harvard. He was the second president who's father was also a president. He initiated the No Child Left Behind Act. He was the first since 1888 to become president without winning the popular votes. He was president during the 9/11 terrorist attacks that killed nearly 3,000 people and began the war in Iraq and Afghanistan.



Calvin
Coolidge

5. U.S. President was his first political office. In 1953 he established the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. In 1957, he sent troops to Arkansas to make sure that black and white children could attend the same school. He was the only president to serve in both World Wars, and was the first president licensed to fly an airplane.
