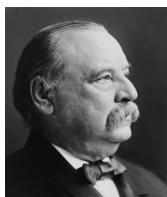




President Matching Game

Cleveland

1. Our 25th president was the first president to use a telephone while campaigning. He made difficult foreign policy decisions, especially going to war with Spain. He was shot twice while in a receiving line and died eight days later.



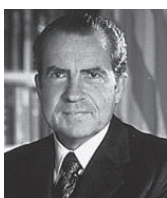
Zachary
Taylor

2. Our first African American president. He worked his way through college, aided by student loans and scholarships, and went on to become the first African American president of the Harvard Law Review. Collects Spiderman and Conan the Barbarian comic books.



William
McKinley

3. Our 12th president had no formal education. He served in the Army for 40 years and never voted, or belonged to a political party until he ran for president at age 62. He let his old Army horse, Whitey, graze on the White House lawn and visitors took horse hairs as souvenirs.



Richard
Nixon

4. Our 22nd president had no formal education. He dedicated the Statue of Liberty in 1886. He is the only president to serve two non-consecutive terms. While sheriff of Erie County, New York, he was the public executioner and personally hanged two murderers. The only president's child born in the White House, was his daughter, Esther.



Barack
Obama

5. Our 37th president sent U.S. troops into Cambodia in 1970. In 1972, five men were arrested for breaking into the Democratic National Committee headquarters in the Watergate Hotel. Following the scandal created by the cover up, he resigned. He was the first to ever voluntarily leave office.
