- 1. He was vice president under Nixon. He later granted Nixon an "absolute pardon" for all crimes he may have committed while president. He was the only president whose two assassination attempts against him were made by women. He and his wife were models before their marriage.
- 2. Our third president was an author of the Declaration of Independence. He died on its 50th anniversary, July 4, 1826. He designed his tombstone and wrote his epitaph, without mentioning that he was president. First to shake hands with visitors. Previously people bowed to presidents.
- 3. Our 10th president graduated from William and Mary College in 1807. He was vice president under Harrison, and the first vice president to take office after the death of a president. He served as president without being a member of any political party. He was a grand-uncle of Harry Truman.
- 4. He graduated from Yale in 1878. He was Secretary of War under Roosevelt. He is the only person to serve as both President and Chief Justice of the U.S. He weighed 332 pounds and got stuck in the White House bathtub the first time he used it. He owned the first White House automobile.
- 5. Our 21st president was vice president under Garfield. His wife died before he became president, so his sister served as White House hostess. He had 24 wagon loads of old furniture and junk removed from the White House before moving in. He entertained lavishly, and enjoyed going to nightclubs.
