

Using Addition to Subtract #1

Find each difference using a related addition fact. Fill in the blanks.

1 Find $9 - 8$.
Think $8 + \underline{\quad} = 9$.
So, $9 - 8 = \underline{\quad}$.

2 Find $5 - 2$.
Think $2 + \underline{\quad} = 5$.
So, $5 - 2 = \underline{\quad}$.

3 Find $7 - 3$.
Think $3 + \underline{\quad} = 7$.
So, $7 - 3 = \underline{\quad}$.

4 Find $6 - 4$.
Think $4 + \underline{\quad} = 6$.
So, $6 - 4 = \underline{\quad}$.

5 Find $10 - 5$.
Think $5 + \underline{\quad} = 10$.
So, $10 - 5 = \underline{\quad}$.

6 Find $13 - 6$.
Think $6 + \underline{\quad} = 13$.
So, $13 - 6 = \underline{\quad}$.

7 Find $18 - 10$.
Think $10 + \underline{\quad} = 18$.
So, $18 - 10 = \underline{\quad}$.

8 Find $15 - 9$.
Think $9 + \underline{\quad} = 15$.
So, $15 - 9 = \underline{\quad}$.
