

Using Addition to Subtract #3

Find each difference using a related addition fact. Fill in the blanks.

1 Find $4 - 2$.
Think $2 + \underline{\quad} = 4$.
So, $4 - 2 = \underline{\quad}$.

2 Find $8 - 3$.
Think $3 + \underline{\quad} = 8$.
So, $8 - 3 = \underline{\quad}$.

3 Find $7 - 1$.
Think $1 + \underline{\quad} = 7$.
So, $7 - 1 = \underline{\quad}$.

4 Find $9 - 0$.
Think $0 + \underline{\quad} = 9$.
So, $9 - 0 = \underline{\quad}$.

5 Find $14 - 10$.
Think $10 + \underline{\quad} = 14$.
So, $14 - 10 = \underline{\quad}$.

6 Find $11 - 6$.
Think $6 + \underline{\quad} = 11$.
So, $11 - 6 = \underline{\quad}$.

7 Find $20 - 5$.
Think $5 + \underline{\quad} = 20$.
So, $20 - 5 = \underline{\quad}$.

8 Find $18 - 15$.
Think $15 + \underline{\quad} = 18$.
So, $18 - 15 = \underline{\quad}$.
