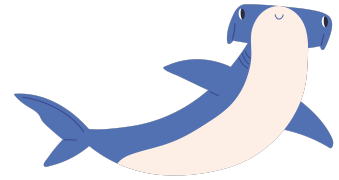


# Using Coordinating Conjunctions: Aquarium
