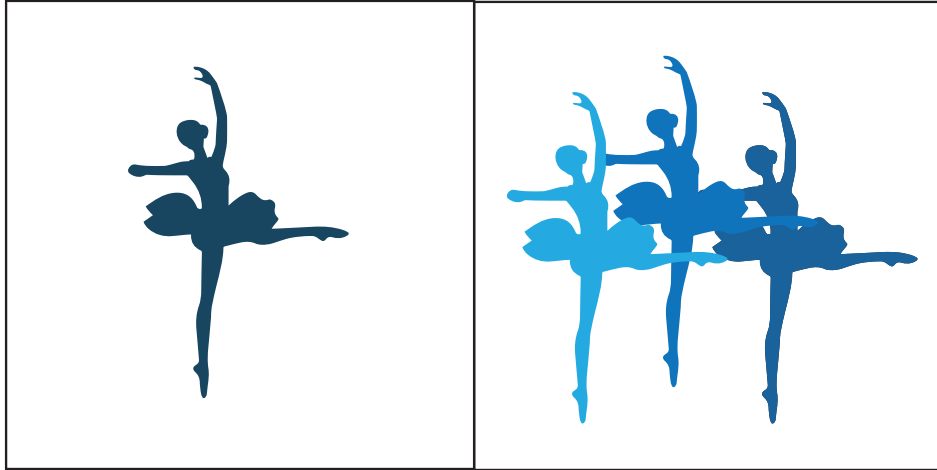


HOW TO USE VERBS
