
HOW TO USE VERBS

When a verb ends in **s**, it usually tells about one person or a thing.

If a verb **doesn't** end with an s, it usually tells about multiple people or things.



The ballerina spins.

Many ballerinas spin.

Many cheetahs run. The cheetah
The gopher digs. Many gophers
Many paintes paint. The painter
The trout swims. Many trout
Many eagles fly. The eagle
The tree grows Many trees
