Superlatives are a form of an adjective or adverb that compares three or more things. For example, the word **short** tells something about one thing, **shorter** tells something about two things and **shortest** tells something about three or more things.

Some superlatives are made by adding -est to the end of a word, like shortest or softest. Others are made by adding "most" before the word, as in most dangerous or most boring.
