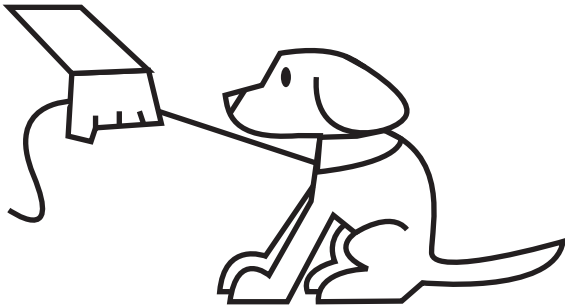

hesitant



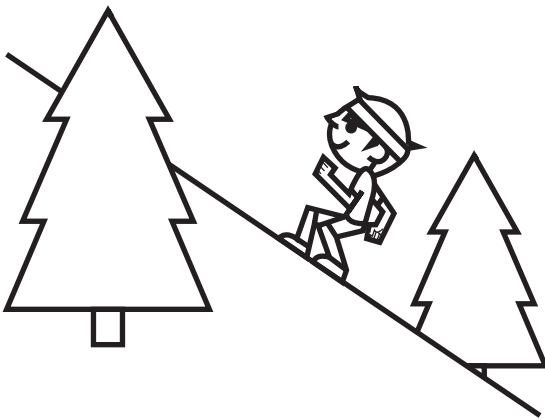
(adj.) Someone who is not feeling sure.

anxious



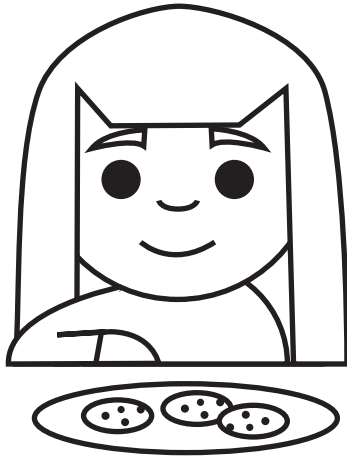
(adj.) Feeling worried, nervous, or afraid about something uncertain.
