$$345 \triangleright 340$$

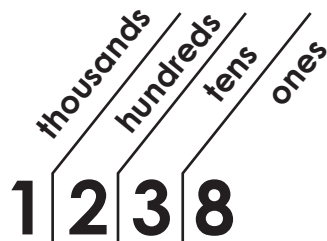
when one value is bigger than another we use a greater than sign
