together to
get another number

greater than

bigger; this symbol ($>$)
means greater than

improper fraction

a fraction where the
numerator (the top number)
is greater than or equal
to the denominator
(the bottom number)

less than

smaller; this symbol ($<$)
means less than

mixed number

a whole number and
a fraction combined into
one "mixed" number

product

the answer to a
