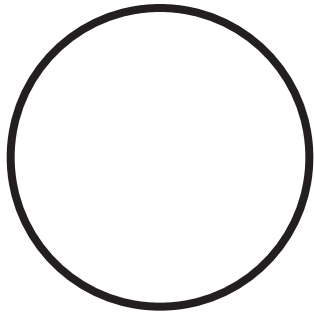

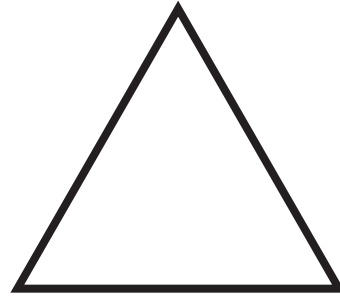

circle



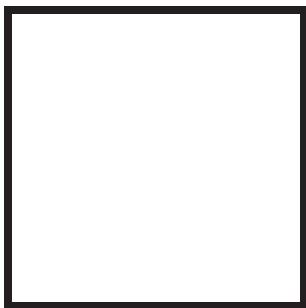
a perfectly round shape: a line that is curved so that its ends meet and every point on the line is the same distance from the center

triangle



a shape that is made up of three lines and three angles

square



a four-sided shape with equal sides, two sets of parallel sides, and four right angles

rectangle



a four-sided shape that is made up of two pairs of parallel lines (one pair of lines is longer than the other pair) and that has four right angles

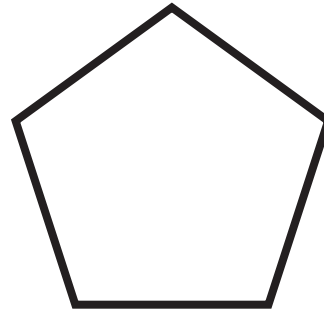

trapezoid



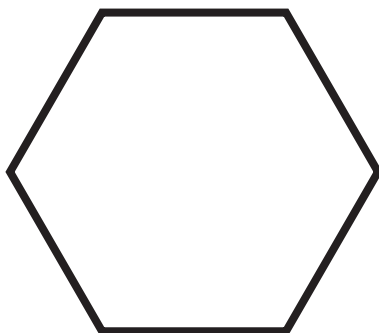
a four-sided shape with one set of parallel sides

pentagon



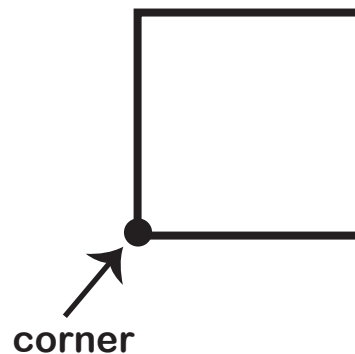
a flat shape that has five sides and five corners

hexagon



a flat shape that has six angles and six sides

corner



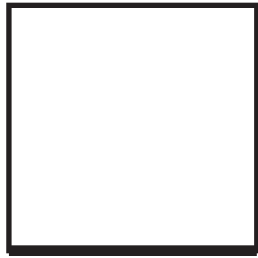
a point where two lines meet to form an angle
