


to make a guess about the amount or size of something

gram




unit of measurement used to measure very light objects, such as a paperclip

unit of measurement used to measure much heavier objects, such as a watermelon

liter




unit of measurement used to measure a large amount of liquid, such as a jug of water





measure



amount of matter or substance that makes up an object; measured in grams and kilograms


to find out the size, length, or amount of something

milliliter



unit of measurement used to measure a much smaller amount possible of liquid, such as the liquid in a medicine dropper

unit



a particular amount of length, time, money, etc., that is used as a standard for counting or measuring
