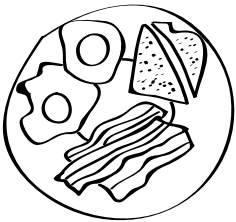


Vowel Digraphs

A vowel digraph is a pair of letters that make a single sound. For example, the vowel digraph **EA** makes a short E sound, and the A is silent, as in **bread**.

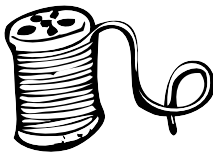
