Did you know? The wedge-tailed eagle is Australia's largest living bird of prey and one of the largest eagles in the world.



They prefer forested areas and open country. The wings of a wedge-tailed eagle are about 7 feet from tip to tip. Its most common food is rabbit, but they also eat lizards, birds and mammals. However, they also eat animals they find already dead, also known as carrion.
