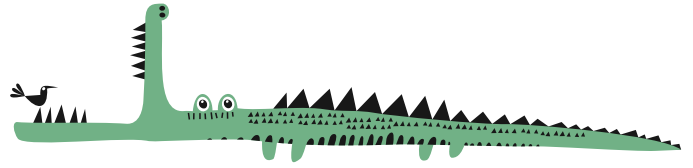


What Is a Metaphor?

A **metaphor** compares two things by saying that one of them is the other. Unlike similes, metaphors don't use the word like or as.



Example: If you wake my sister too early, she is a snapping crocodile.
