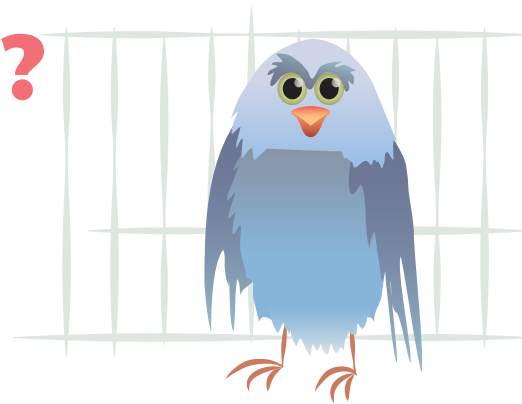


# When Did It Happen?

## Exploring Adverbs 3

An **adverb** is a word that describes a verb.
