Words with **prefixes** and **suffixes** follow patterns. These patterns help us figure out the meanings of words. Here are some examples.

angle : **tri**angle A triangle is a shape with *three* angles.

cycle : **tri**cycle A tricycle is a cycle with *three* wheels.
