An **analogy** is a way of describing the similarities between two things by comparing them.

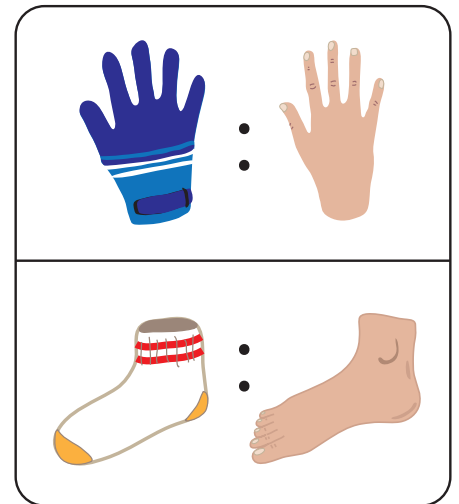
Example:
