

Seven Wonders of the World



TGAER YMIPARD FO IGAZ

Located in Egypt, it served as a tomb for the 4th dynasty Egyptian Pharaoh Khufu.



MPLEET FO SATMREI

Built for the goddess of fertility, this massive structure is considered to be one of the largest temples constructed during the ancient times.



GGIHANAN DNEAGRS FO YBLOABN

King Nebuchadnezzar built this for his wife to have a lovely, private, terraced garden to enjoy.



EMALMSOUU TA SSLIRHSCAAUAN

This world wonder serves as the burial tomb for King Mausolus.



GLHITOUHES FO XAELIRDAAN

Built in the Island of Pharos around 290 BC, it was a working lighthouse that helped ships find their way safely into the harbor.

As a symbol of their victory, the city of Rhodes celebrated by making a statue of the Greek Titan Helios.
