









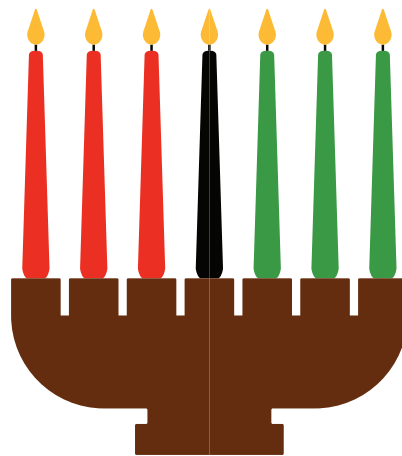
WRITE A HABARI GANI KWANZAA CARD

Habari Gani means “What is the news?” in Swahili. It is a common greeting used during the celebration of Kwanzaa. Each day of Kwanzaa focuses on one of seven principles. The traditional reply to *Habari Gani* is to say the principle of that day of the celebration.
