Write Complex Sentences

A complex sentence has an independent clause and a dependent clause.

- An independent clause is a complete thought, and it can stand alone as a sentence.
- A dependent clause is not a complete thought, so it can not stand alone as a sentence.

In a **complex sentence**, the dependent clause usually begins with a subordinating conjunction such as because, if, after, when, since, or unless. For example:

If it snows today, <u>I will put on my puffy jacket</u>.
