
WRITING ALGEBRAIC EXPRESSIONS

To translate a verbal expression into an algebraic expression, first look for key words that tell you whether the expression involves addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division.



Addition Phrases	Subtraction Phrases	Multiplication Phrases	Division Phrases
Plus Sum Total Increased by More than	Minus Difference Subtracted from Decreased by Less than	Times Multiplied by Product of Twice	Quotient Divided by

Look at these examples:

7 increased by *n*

10 less than *h*

3 times the total of 6 and x

7 + n

h - 10

3(6 + x)
