Meaning: 'alien horned-face'

Length: 6 meters long (20 feet!)

Height: 3 meters tall (10 feet!)

Weight: 2 Tons (4,000 pounds!)

Diet: Plant eater (Herbivore)

Period: 83 to 76 Million Years ago
(Late Cretaceous Period)

Defense: Two hook-like horns just above the brow and a large shield emerging from its skull. The shield was lined with frills and two massive spikes at the top.
